# FORTIS HEALTHCARE SUSTAINABILITY POLICY

#### 1. Introduction

- (c) "Fortis" / "Fortis Group" means all operational facilities, existing / under construction, under the Company and its subsidiaries, irrespective of their geographical location.
- (d) "Policy" means Sustainability Policy as envisaged in this document.

- Create equal opportunities for all employees in the Organization;

- Ensure that employees are fully aware of our Sustainability Policy and are committed to implementing and improving it.
